All students will receive a completion grade of 20 points for their first trimester Math grade.

The checklist below states the 11 skills in 8 categories that your child is REQUIRED to complete. The student should answer a minimum of 10-15 questions for each skill. Each student should strive for 80% mastery in order to get full credit for this assignment.

If your child is struggling, IXL will provide an explanation of how to correctly solve the problem. We encourage students to pace their IXL work throughout the entire summer and not wait until the last minute to complete.
