**Basketball Update Week 2**

7th grade girls had a tough game against a very strong St. Mark team this weekend but fought hard for 28 minutes and refused to be shut out. Scoring was shared by Harper Rodeghero, Mia Ly Doucet-Nguyen and Mikayla Williams with a basket each.

Our 4<sup>th</sup> grade girls, playing in only their 2<sup>nd</sup> CYO League game ever, didn't come away with a "W" BUT did hold their opponent to half the points scored against them the week before. Improvement in their defense is starting to show. I feel a win is coming soon.
