Here are the highlights from this past weekend:

In the inaugural Championship weekend of the Archdiocese of Baltimore Soccer Program (ABSP) St. Casimir had three teams step onto the field.

U10 Boys - White, U10 Boys - Blue, and U10 Girls - Red. Huge congratulations to all of our student athletes who worked hard to get to this point.

The U10 Boys - White, composed of St. Casimir and Our Lady of Hope boys, having finished 3rd in the regular season, had an initial playoff game where they defeated St. Joseph Fullerton 2:1 off of a game-ending penalty kick, converted by Leo Smith. This put them into the final later in the day against a much stronger Cathedral team where they were not able to realize victory but still persevered to represent Casimir well and walk away as FINALISTS.

The U10 Boys - Blue, composed of St. Casimir and Our Lady of Hope boys, having finished 2nd in the regular season, had a thriller of a game with lots of back and forth play, neither team wanting to budge and risk an error.
