BASKETBALL UPDATE WEEK #1

Anchors basketball got underway this past weekend with 3 teams competing and "out of the box", our **4th grade boys** forced a "double overtime" game against IHM. While we came out on the short end of a 7-4 game, we took the lead at 4-2, then gave up a bucket to send us 4-4 into the first OT. Then in the second OT, a Hail Mary, eyes closed, off-balance, and a 3-pointer somehow found the inside of the ring. This was a total team effort displaying a tenacious team defense, and as Coach Bridget states "the goal this year is to become the best defensive team in the league, and holding an opponent to four points in regulation, and seven across two overtimes, shows they're already on that path."
